EXTRA DAY SCORES

From 15th July, Extra Day Scores will be accepted without restrictions as established in the World Handicap System.

The procedure will remain as per below:

- The player informs the club of his intention to present an EDS
- The club tells the player whether the course is prepared for an EDS to be played
- Having completed the round, the player hands in his card to the club. It must be signed by the player and a marker.
- The club processes the result using its competition software.

The possibility of allowing players (with prior authorisation from the club) to present an EDS directly using an electronic card is being assessed.

This modification in the EDS could have a large impact on some players' handicaps. With this in mind a number of mechanisms and controls will be introduced shortly to help Committees reject any player who does not comply with these controls. The controls will be established by the club and the RFEG will provide the data and parameters for the Committee to make a decision.

Finally, a reminder to Committees to adapt the Conditions of their competitions that have already been published to the new EDS situation.
