THE VENUE

REAL SOCIEDAD HÍPICA ESPAÑOLA CLUB DE CAMPO

The first 18 holes of golf were completed in 1997. With special importance it is worth highlighting the celebrations of the 1st. centenary events that occurred during the years 2001 and 2002, the Madrid Open in 2007 and the Madrid Masters Golf 2010.

Currently, the RSHECC, located at Km. 26,400 of the A-1, has 6,000 members, 36 golf holes designed by Robert Von Hagge, a driving range and approach and putting greens area, a par 3 course, equestrian facilities and pony club, two croquet fields, tennis and paddle tennis courts, gym, swimming pools, social chalet, events pavilion, children's chalet, family recreation area and a large expanse of meadows and open spaces for the enjoyment of its members and guests.

CAMPO NORTE - HOLE BY HOLE DESCRIPTION

Hole 1: It is a very accessible par 5 as long as you put the ball on the fairway. Hole with clear recovery where you can get a birdie and sometimes even eagles with relative ease.

Hole 2: To the right or to the left of the oak tree? water or complicated rough? The position of the flag will define the difficulty of the hole.

Hole 3: Hole of apparent tranquillity, open and almost straight. Once again the position of the flag makes this an easy or difficult hole.

Hole 4: It is important to place the driver well, because the green is very defended and, if not, the second shot is much more complicated. Going over the green can be very expensive for your card...

Hole 5: This is a hole where you can show your skill as a player. You can deliver a spectacular blow. The wind can vary the choice of club.

Hole 6: Very long, the second most difficult hole on the course. Once again, driver placement is essential. Be careful when leaning too much on the left, as you can end up in the bad rough area between the 13th and 15th fairways or give a scare to a player who is playing on the 13th fairway.

Hole 7: Very long hole, but...the temptation to play it on the left carries a risk. Although the hole is greatly shortened, there are out of bounds and strategically placed bunkers.

Hole 8: What is easy can be very complicated. If you don't hit the green, any approach is complicated and you end up with a bad feeling.

Hole 9: Assuming that you have placed the driver correctly, the difficulty of this hole is on the green due to its complicated drops and flag positions.

















CAMPO NORTE - HOLE BY HOLE DESCRIPTION

Hole 10: Start the game carefully and stand to the left of the hole. The ladies have an advantage in general, they put the ball down. Caution, if we shorten to the left, the ball will remain in an impossible rough.

Hole 11: Do not be aggressive to avoid passing the green. Otherwise there will be a difficult return shot. The flag position can make it a very easy hole or a tremendously complicated one.

Hole 12: It is not difficult if you play with your head and strategy. The temptation is to shoot to the right to shorten, but most of the time, the state of the rough does not allow the ball to roll into the fairway. Better to hit center left.

Hole 13: This hole is a challenge to intelligence. And you have to analyze the strategy well. It has two possible exits on both sides of the stream that cuts through the street. Depending on the side of the stream where the bars are placed, one suit or another is played. If you miss the second hit, it's a nightmare.

Hole 14: The key is the second shot to a narrow, uphill green. Be careful, on the left it is complicated, there is a hazard. The field challenges you again, to devise an intelligent strategy.

Hole 15: Challenge for hitting players because they can reach the green with the driver knowing that the shot is blind. His thing is to be conservative.

Hole 16: The difficulty is in placing the ball on the flag platform. Choose the stick well. You will be able to contemplate a Sabina that is more than 500 years old.

Hole 17: It is a blind exit that should be played on the left. It wouldn't be a bad idea for the ladies to ring the bell when they came down. We would avoid more than one disappointment when we play ladies and gentlemen. We recommend looking back: wonderful views from the green.

Hole 18: It is one of the most difficult in the club, where "the eagles nest" is located. This hole is unforgiving. The prevailing wind is almost always against you and you have to hit a very strong driver, with the difficulty that the fairway is uphill. All shots are difficult on this hole, any mistake is costly.











OFFICIAL AIRPORT AND TRANSPORTATION

Your closest flight destination is Madrid-Barajas Airport, located 15 minute drive to RSHECC and 15 minute drive to the city of Madrid and the official Hotel Meliá Castilla. (How to get there)

Transportation will be arranged on arrival and departure for Teams and Officials arriving at Madrid Airport. Please, indicate your itinerary on the <u>Travelling Details' Form</u> (page 18) and return it to us by email as soon as possible and no later than May 31, 2024.
