SPANISH INTERNATIONAL SENIOR MENS' AMATEUR CHAMPIONSHIPS (DOUBLES & INDIVIDUAL)

Real Club de Golf El Prat – 17-18 & 19-21 February 2026

In addition to the Conditions of Competition, Regulations, Permanent Local Rules and Code of Conduct and Pace of Play Policy of the Royal Spanish Golf Federation 2025, the following will apply:

LOCAL RULES

1. **OUT OF BOUNDS (Rule 2.1)**

The course boundaries are defined by white lines, white stakes, and the fence surrounding the course.

2. **ABNORMAL COURSE CONDITIONS (Rule 16)**

- Paths surfaced with asphalt or concrete. All other paths and trails are considered integral parts of the course (including those covered with gravel)
- Damage in the general area caused by wild boars, even if not marked as ground under repair (GUR)
- The electric fence, when located within the course, is considered an immovable obstruction.
- Blue stakes with a yellow top are movable obstructions, and do not identify any abnormal course condition.
- Logs and branches that have fallen and been piled up for removal are considered GUR.
- Logs that have been cut for removal are considered GUR.

3. **LABORED AND CULTIVATED FIELDS**. Labored and cultivated fields on the course are part of the general area and are considered "rough."

4. **WASTE AREAS**

These areas, without grass with bunker appearance.

- Hole 6: In front of and around the green.
- Hole 10: At the beginning of the fairway, to the right.
- Hole 14: To the left of the fairway.

They are part of the general area and are considered "rough," so practice swings and grounding the club are allowed without penalty.

5. **INTEGRAL OBJECTS – No relief without penalty**

- Paths and trails that are not surfaced with asphalt or concrete (including those covered with gravel)

6. **DROPPING ZONE (DZ). MLR-1.1.**

Hole 13. There is an optional dropping zone for balls that are known or virtually certain to lie in the red penalty area to the left of the hole. See point 7 (Preferred Lies)

7. **PREFERRED LIES. MLR E-3**

When a player's ball lies in a part of the general area cut to fairway height or less, the player may take relief without penalty once, by placing the original ball or another ball in the general area within a distance of 30 centimeters (12 inches) and not closer to the hole. This MLR also applies to a ball lying in the dropping zone on the 13th hole.

Penalty for breach of these Local Rules Two strokes

Important Notes:

- Slow play will be timed as soon as it is observed.
- A referee's decisions are final, and only him or her could grant a second opinion.**
- Player unsporting behaviour will be reason for disqualification.
